• Do not apply in direct sunlight.

• Use as is, do not thin.

Application	<ul> <li>Rinse the surface with fresh water. Remove dirt and heavy oxidation by scrubbing with DECK CLEANER* per label instructions. Allow surface to completely dry.</li> <li>Saturate a SOFT cloth with GELCOAT RESTORER and wipe it on.</li> <li>With a SOFT cloth, wipe off excess within 10 minutes.</li> <li>Gently polish with a lint-free cloth to a new sheen.</li> </ul>
Coverage	<ul> <li>193 ft² (18 m²) per litre.</li> <li>Actual coverage will vary depending on type, age and texture of surface.</li> </ul>
Clean-up	Clean all tools and equipment with mineral spirits while still wet. If allowed to dry, remove with paint stripper.  NOTE: Any rags, steel wool etc soaked in GELCOAT RESTORER may spontaneously catch fire if improperly discarded. Rags, steel wool etc must be saturated with water after use or placed in a sealed, water filled metal container, before disposing with household waste.
Storage	<ul> <li>Left over GELCOAT RESTORER should be transferred to a smaller, airtight, closed metal or glass container.</li> <li>Keep from freezing and high temperature.</li> </ul>
